Entertainment Internship

You are the star of the show with this internship! This role focuses on everything that happens outside of baseball during a Bravehearts game. This role will work with the Bravehearts entertainment team and join in on things like pre-game ceremonies, in-between inning promotions and sponsored activations. Some aspects of this internship include:

- Script Writing
- Assisting with pre-game ceremonies (first pitch, national anthem, etc)
- Stage managing on-field promotions
- Participating in and creating in-stand skits
- Handling and wearing mascot suit
- Coordinating sponsored promotions and activations
- Helping to assist VIP Guests who will be participating in events

Interns will also work on non-gamedays if a non-baseball event is happening at the stadium or if field upkeep is required. Compensation is hourly and based on a weekly schedule.
